TELEHEALTH MENTAL HEALTH CARE PLAN FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 7–8

1. Purpose

Progeny’s Telehealth Mental Health Care Plan ensures equitable access to confidential mental health services for students in grades 7–8 by providing private, school-based spaces for telehealth sessions during instructional hours and staff-available periods.

2. Space Allocation and Access

- Progeny has identified the following spaces to be used for private telehealth rooms: Room 207, Office 201, Office 205, Office 105.
- These spaces can be used during school hours and, if staff are available, before/after school on instructional days.
- To request access to these spaces, contact the school Director

3. Technology and Device Use

- If needed, students may use school devices (e.g., laptops, tablets) for telehealth sessions, provided usage aligns with district/school acceptable-use policies.

4. Consent and Documentation

- A student requesting access to space under this section must submit to the school a signed and dated consent from the student's parent or guardian authorizing the student's licensed mental health provider to release information from the student's health record that is requested by the school to confirm the student is currently receiving mental health care from the provider. Such a consent is valid for the school year in which it is submitted.
